We would like to extend to you warm wishes this Spring semester. This month, the Division of Student Affairs will be conducting two surveys designed to further understand your experiences at TCNJ. Data from these surveys will be used to guide our efforts to provide services that best fit your needs. If you are randomly selected we kindly appreciate your participation and please note you may be asked to complete both surveys.

The Title IX Office and the Alcohol and Drug Education Program (ADEP) have each partnered with the Center for Institutional Effectiveness to randomly select undergraduate students for each survey. Both surveys will be conducted online via email and can be completed at your own pace. We greatly value your contributions and strongly encourage your participation.

The first survey is the Campus Climate survey which will be administered during the entire month of February. This survey will examine the climate of TCNJ by reviewing important topics such as sexual violence, diversity, and community on campus. The second survey is the American College Health Association's National College Health Assessment (ACHA-NCHA II). This survey includes questions on a variety of health-related topics including: stress, sleep, exercise, nutrition, and alcohol and other drug use. The survey will be sent via email during the first week of March.. Your responses will help provide TCNJ with accurate information regarding health/wellness behaviors on our campus.
